Instructions:

- 1.) Follow this link - <https://ds.calstate.edu/?svc=sumtotal>
- 2.) Login to CSU Learn with your student credentials
- 3.) Search "CSU CHICO DEFENSIVE DRIVER PROGRAM"
- 4.) Select option with a car icon and follow language "CSU CHICO DEFENSIVE DRIVER PROGRAM"
- 5.) "Register" for course and begin
- 6.) Complete the training and print out the certificate at the end
 - a. Drivers must pass the course with an 80%
- 7.) Screenshot your completed status (see below) and upload it to your club registration.
 - a. NOTE: your view will so 75% completed
